- Completion of prerequisites to be eligible to register for ENG 111 without co-requisite
- Completion of ENG 111 or equivalent with a "C" or better
- Provide satisfactory scores on NCDAP, COMPASS, ACCUPLACER, ASSET, SAT, ACT, GED, or HiSET
- Have a 2.8 or higher unweighted high school GPA within the past 10 years
- Provide proof of completion of an associate's degree or higher

### MATH: proficiency should be satisfied by completion of any **ONE** of the following (*within the past 10 years*):

- A college level mathematics course at the freshman level or higher from a U.S. regionally accredited institution with a minimum grade of "C"
- Meet course prerequisite to take MAT 143
- Provide satisfactory scores on NCDAP, COMPASS, ACCUPLACER, ASSET, SAT, ACT, GED, or HiSET
- Have a 2.8 or higher unweighted high school GPA within the past 10 years
- Provide proof of completion of an associate's or bachelor's degree

### CHEMISTRY: proficiency should be satisfied by completion of any **ONE** of the following:

- High School (one full unit) or College Chemistry course with a minimum grade of "C"
- CHM 090 with a minimum grade of "C"
- Successful completion of CheMOOC with passing final exam

**TEAS Scores:** All Radiography Clinical applicants must take the ATI TEAS. All 4 sections of the exam (Reading, English, Math and Science) are required. A composite score of 63% or higher will award additional points. All official score reports must be received from testing sites other than Wake Tech. ATI TEAS or TEAS V scores must be within 3 years of submitting your Radiography (clinical) application.
