- Meet score on placement test to be eligible to register for ENG 111 without co-requisite (SAT, ACT, CPT, HiSET, or GED)
- A college level English composition course with a minimum grade of "C"
- Completion of prerequisites to be eligible to register for ENG 111 without co-requisite
- Unweighted 2.8 high school GPA within past 10 years

English Language Proficiency Requirement
